Registration information is now available online for the District's Mid Year conference up in Albany. It will be held from February 15-17 at the Desmond Hotel. 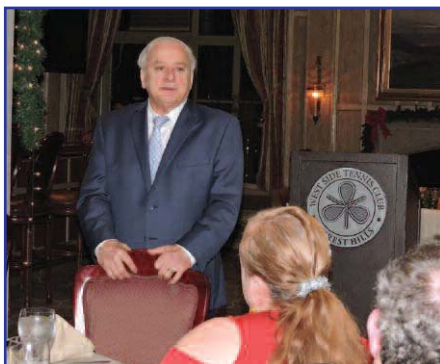

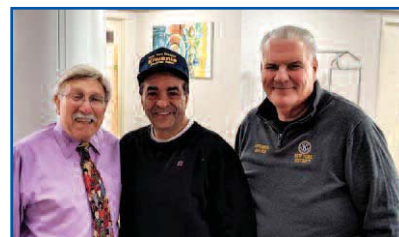
Forest Hills Club Officer's & Director's Installation

Kiwanis License Plates are finally here!



Now we Kiwanians can proudly advertise our love of Kiwanis! New custom vanity Kiwanis plates are available. Through the efforts of several people we were able to obtain permission to get these vanity plates. However, a special thanks to NYS Assemblyman and two-time Past Queens West Lieutenant Governor, Michael Miller of the Glendale Kiwanis Club and NYS Senator, as well as West Seneca member, Patrick Gallivan for their diligent efforts to obtain these plates.

The license plates require the submission of a New York District authorization letter (just fill in your name on the blank line), custom plate form and payment, which cannot be done online. You have the choice of having the DMV assign a plate number to you or choosing a personalized number. The cost of an assigned plate number is \$85 and a personalized plate is \$116.25. There are also bi-annual renewal fees of \$56.25 for assigned and \$87.50 for personalized plates.

Go to <https://dmv.ny.gov/plates/kiwanis-international> to review the requirements and fees. To see if your personalized plate is available go to: <https://transact2.dmv.ny.gov/platespersonalized/>. However, if you're ready to go, just head straight to your local DMV and get your new Kiwanis license plates!

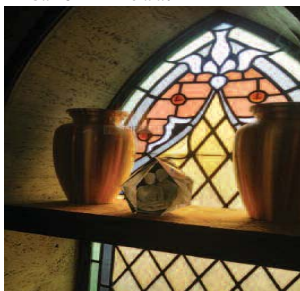
