Juvenile Diabetes... The story of a survivor

Interviewed by JP Di Troia



Our Kiwanis family has been helping many organizations to reach their realization of saving lives and helping the community one child, one family, one senior at a time. One of the organizations is Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation (<http://nyc.jdrf.org>)

I recently had a conversation with my niece Marion Patanjo who has Juvenile Diabetes.

Me: Hello Marion, I would like to share the story about your battle with Juvenile Diabetes. When were you first diagnosed with the disease?

Marion: I've been a diabetic since I was two years old.

Me: What was the prognosis from the doctors?

Marion: Back then my parents were told I would be lucky if I see my 18th birthday.

Me: How old are you now?

Marion: I am now 39 years old.

Me: That is quite a difference in your original prognosis. What changed in the medical field to extend your life?

Marion: Well luckily for me treatment for the disease has made some progress through the efforts of JDRF. I first was diagnosed as diabetic at age two. Through the efforts of JDRF things have changed in the world in the way diabetics test themselves, doctors diagnose diabetes and they provide tools for treatment.

ME: What other inroads have we made to fight the disease?

Marion: Diabetes can now be some what under control by having an artificial pump installed to control the pancreas. I am fortunate enough to have a pump which injects insulin directly into my body to help me stay healthy. The donations that the diabetes foundation receives helps them to do research which enabled them to teach diabetics the importance of taking care of their health to control the disease. We are also better educated, so that we can take better steps in the proper nutrition and exercise programs. We eat Better and work out to, help control the disease. After all I am the living proof of that.

Me: Do you have children?

Marion: I have a 9 year old boy.

Me: How is your day to day life living with the disease?

Marion: For me it is a day to day effort to control this disease and work hard as a teacher so that I may help and provide for my family together with my husband. The disease is an added burden, but has challenged me and has made me stronger to face the day to day set backs that the effects of the disease has on my body.

Me: What are the side effects of the disease on your health?

Marion: Besides monitoring my blood for sugar, I have to be vigil on the condition on my eyes, my heart, and neuropathy which can cause pain. Also, any poor circulation which if not monitored, it can cause me to loose limbs.

Me: Is there anything you would like to say to the Kiwanis family.

Marion: I am grateful for the Kiwanis Family who gave with their hearts and who has supported the diabetes foundation. If it were not for their support and of others, my success story could not be told. But there is still more work to do. Our goal is to wipe the disease out completely. So please continue your support. I thank you from the bottom of my heart for the good work that you all do and with your fundraising efforts for the JDRF.

Me: We want you to know we will continue to champion the cause. Just last year our Kiwanis Queens West Division has raised over \$18,000. for JDRF. I am truly proud of our division last year with the leadership of our past Lieutenant Governor Steven Sirgiovanni for making it his project. We will continue our efforts. God bless and thank you for sharing with us your battle with the disease.


